Michigan Colored Pencil 2023 is a 100% colored pencil art exhibition, open to all members of CPSA, CPSA Detroit District Chapter #104, and all Michigan and northern Ohio artists.

Eligibility:

Artist must be 18 or over and a resident of Michigan, northern Ohio, or a member of CPSA and CPSA Detroit #104. Artists may submit up to three (3) 2-dimensional original works of art, **completed within the last five (5) years** that have **not** been shown previously in any “Michigan Colored Pencil” exhibit.

Artwork Specifications:

- *Media must be 100% colored pencil on a manufacturer-prepared surface (scratchboard not allowed).
- *Acceptable colored pencil products can be found at www.cpsa.org on “Show Requirements” under the Shows/Events tab (each artwork cannot exceed 32”x 40” framed).
- *Each artwork must have Plexiglas (acrylic) with a hook and eye/wire hanger (NO sawtooth hangers). Any artwork with glass and or sawtooth hangers will be rejected.
- *Artwork must be 2 dimensional. No collage or montage.

Concept, design, and execution of the artwork shall be solely that of the artist.:

- *No work copied from copyrighted or published materials.
- *No images produced by drawing over a digital reproduction allowed.
- *No work copied from someone else’s photograph—even with permission.

Entry Fees:

CPSA Members

- * \$15.00 for the first picture
- * \$10.00 for each additional picture —up to three (3) pictures total entered

Non-CPSA Artists

- * \$20.00 for the first picture
- * \$15.00 for each additional picture—up to three (3) pictures total entered

Fees are due with entry form and jpeg image(s) by the deadline, **postmarked by August 28, 2023.**

Sale of Artwork

Prices will be marked (or NFS plus a stated value) on artworks. Color | Ink Studio will collect a **20% commission**. All artwork must remain for the duration of the exhibition.
